

# UCLA Financial Aid Office

## NEED-BASED UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS

The Financial Aid Office administers over 250 privately funded *need-based* scholarships to assist UCLA undergraduate students. Scholarship awards range from \$500 to \$3000 per student, depending on academic accomplishments and overall financial need.

**University scholarships are awarded for one year only and are not automatically renewable.**

**Continuing UCLA undergraduates** must complete the on-line *Continuing Undergraduate Scholarship Application* each year.

- The *Continuing Undergraduate Scholarship Application* will be posted on the Financial Aid website ([www.fao.ucla.edu](http://www.fao.ucla.edu)) on January 8.
- Application deadline: **March 2 (12 midnight)**
- Must have a cumulative 3.5 GPA
- Must file a FAFSA by March 2
- Must have financial need as determined by the Financial Aid Office

### **Margaret Campbell Scholarship**

- ◆ *Scholarship awarded to students preparing for a career in the field of teaching.*

### **Barbara Cannon Memorial Scholarship**

- ◆ *Students interested in a career in the health science. Preference is given to students who have lost a parent to cancer.*

### **Del Rey Fraternity Scholarship**

- ◆ *Scholarship established to assist descendants of the Del Rey Fraternity. Scholarship can be used to assist members of any fraternity or sorority.*

### **Finerman Scholarship**

- ◆ *Scholarship awarded to graduating seniors who have been admitted to graduate school at UCLA or to another accredited university.*

### **Albert Fisher Trust Undergraduate Scholarship**

- ◆ *Established to support students planning a career in medicine or who are interested in the sciences.*

### **Gertler Family Foundation**

- ◆ *Established in 1991 to assist needy entering UCLA freshmen.*

### **Gordon E. Hein Scholarship Fund**

- ◆ *Established to assist students who are blind.*

### **E. Lee Kinsey Memorial Scholarship**

- ◆ *Established to assist a student entering their senior year in the Physics Department.*

#### **Ivan S. Meitus Jewish Memorial Scholarship**

- ◆ *Established to assist Jewish undergraduate students*

#### **A & R Miller Scholarship**

- ◆ *Established to support scholarships for unmarried freshmen*

#### **Will Rodger Scholarship**

- ◆ *Provides assistance to disabled students or students pursuing studies that would directly benefit the disabled.*

#### **Maxine & Eugene Rosenfeld Scholarship**

- ◆ *Provides assistance to disabled students*

#### **Lorrie Ross Memorial Scholarship**

- ◆ *Provides scholarship support to entering freshmen, who have indicated intentions to major in Humanities, Liberal Arts and the Fine Arts.*

#### **Angelina Ruggie Scholarship Fund**

- ◆ *Provides scholarship support for students pursuing studies in the Humanities, Law or Social Work.*

#### **Steven J. Sackler Scholarship**

- ◆ *Provides an annual scholarship to an undergraduate who is experiencing a major illness such as cancer, heart disease, cystic fibrosis or physical disability, with first priority given to a cancer patient.*

#### **Mark G. & Florence M. Simpson Scholarship**

- ◆ *Preference given to students majoring in business and engineering.*

#### **Norman E. Smith Science Scholarship**

- ◆ *Supports scholarships for students in the Division of Physical Sciences, with preference given to chemistry students.*

#### **Frederick R. Waingrow Scholarship**

- ◆ *Provides scholarships for continuing undergraduate students who are interested in careers in publishing, communications or the media.*

### **Ancestry, Ethnicity, National Origin or Religion**

#### **Barough-Siegel Memorial Scholarship**

- ◆ *Provides assistance to one foreign student attending UCLA with preference given to students from Africa. The scholarship is awarded on the basis of financial need, academic achievement and the candidate's interest in the field of international relations.*

#### **Chi Alpha Delta Scholarship**

- ◆ *Provides assistance to a deserving Japanese-American woman who shows academic promise in her chosen field of study. A strong academic record and financial need are required.*

#### **Alfred C. Darby Estate Scholarship**

- ◆ *Preference is given to African-American students.*

#### **Sidney Lanier Scholarship**

- ◆ *Members of the children of the Confederacy of a California Division or a member of the United Daughters of the Confederacy, California Division.*

### **Living Memorial Daughters of the Union Veterans of the Civil War**

- ◆ *Descendants of Civil War veterans.*

### **Annes & Mima Malouf Educational Fund**

- ◆ *Preference given to students who are American citizens of Lebanese or Syrian ancestry.*

### **Mangasir M. Mangasarian Scholarship**

- ◆ *Preference given to students who have at least one parent who is of pure Armenian stock. Academic interests must exclude theological, sectarian or religious studies.*

### **Georgia Oleson-Dankanyin**

- ◆ *Provides financial assistance to two underrepresented minority students. One must be a female with financial need and academic potential. This scholarship is renewable for four years, as long as the recipient maintains the academic requirements set-forth by the Financial Aid Scholarship Office.*

### **William M. Ortega Scholarship Fund**

- *Provides financial assistance to students of Mexican descent or ancestry (and must bear a Spanish surname). Must be a U.S. Citizen and must be able to speak and understand the Spanish language. Students are also evaluated based on academic merit and financial need.*

### **Paulson Scholarship Fund**

- ◆ *Provides support to students from Sweden.*

### **Lulie Scattergood**

- ◆ *Provides assistance to students who are descendants of Confederate veterans or who are from old and notably worthy Southern families. Verification of lineage is required.*

### **Werner Scott Scholarship Fund**

- ◆ *Provides support to male or female Caucasian students who reside in the Territory of Hawaii and who are not of Polynesian blood.*

### **Otto Shaler Scholarship Fund**

- ◆ *Provides support to needy foreign students regardless of color, creed or parentage.*

### **Malcolm R. Stacey Scholarship Fund**

- ◆ *Provides support to needy, orphaned students of Jewish parentage.*

## **School, Employment, or Geographic Location**

### **Thomas Adams Memorial Scholarship**

- ◆ *Entering freshmen who graduate from a public or private Los Angeles County High School.*

### **Sarah M. Armstrong Scholarship**

- ◆ *Preference given to students from Hayward or Alameda Counties in California.*

### **May Ballard Scholarship**

- ◆ *Residents of the State of California, with preference given to students who have financial need.*

### **James C. Basile Scholarship**

- ◆ *Graduates of a public or private high school within the boundaries of Simi Valley or Moorpark (Ventura County, California). One or both parents (natural or adoptive) must have been killed or physically disabled while actively engaged in law enforcement service or while actively engaged in public service as a fire fighter*

**Bettlemen Educational Fund**

- ◆ *Preference given to U.S. Citizens who are California residents and who have maintained a grade-point average between 3.0 and 3.7. Scholar selection made by the donor.*

**Yvonne Braithwaite-Burke Scholarship Foundation**

- ◆ *Entering freshmen who reside in South Los Angeles.*

**Johnny Cochran Sr. Scholarship**

- ◆ *Provides scholarship assistance to students who have graduated from a public or private Los Angeles County high school.*

**Linda Taylor-Ferguson Memorial Scholarship**

- ◆ *Supports needy students who graduated from a public or private Los Angeles County high school.*

**Guy T. Ellis Scholarship (Formerly GTE; now Verizon)**

- ◆ *Provides scholarship to UCLA students whose parents or grandparents are employed at Verizon.*

**Faculty Women Scholarship**

- ◆ *For Spouses or children of a UCLA faculty member*

**Charles Gleason Scholarship Fund**

- ◆ *Provides scholarships to graduates of San Jose High Academy.*

**Mary E. Jaskey Scholarship Fund**

- ◆ *Provides financial assistance to graduates of Riverside Junior College (Riverside, California).*

**Gordon- MacNeil Scholarship Fund**

- ◆ *Graduates from the Citrus Union High School District.*

**Picard-Lurmann Scholarship Fund**

- ◆ *California and Nevada residents*

**Mary Pillot Scholarship Fund**

- ◆ *Graduates from San Jose High Academy. Recipients are nominated by the high school principal.*

**George Quist Memorial Scholarship (bequeathed to UC, Berkeley)**

- ◆ *Scholarship established to honor graduates of Mission High School, San Francisco. If Mission High School graduates are not eligible through UC, Berkeley, other UC campuses are given opportunities to nominate a student for the Quist scholarship.*

**Edward Charles Uffert Trust**

- ◆ *Scholarship established to assist needy students from Kern County, California.*

**Frank MacArthur Scholarship**

- ◆ *Established to assist UCLA students who graduated from Modoc or Lassen County, California high schools.*

## **GENDER**

### **Betty Bachman Scholarship**

- ◆ *Preference given to female students studying zoology or the biological sciences.*

### **Jean C. Cook Estate Scholarship**

- ◆ *Established to assist women who need financial assistance to further their education.*

### **Deborah King Scholarship Fund**

- ◆ *Established to assist women who are majoring in English Literature or Classic Latin Literature.*

### **Faculty Women's Scholarship**

- ◆ *Established to support annual scholarships for female students in their junior or senior year. Selection is based on scholarly achievement and financial need. Students are interviewed by the Faculty Women's Scholarship Committee and a separate application is required.*

### **William Glenn Homan Memorial Scholarship**

- ◆ *Established to support scholarships for male undergraduate students majoring in mathematics, physical science, or biological science.*

### **Los Angeles Pan Hellenic Scholarship**

- ◆ *Established to provide assistance to students who are interested in pursuing graduate work. Preference is to be given to female students.*

### **John and Lena Luckenbach Scholarship**

- ◆ *Established to provide scholarships for female students.*

### **Mabel Wilson Richards Scholarship**

- ◆ *Established to assist female students who demonstrate high moral character, is a U.S. citizen or parents must be a permanent resident. Must have financial need and have maintained a minimum 3.0 GPA while attending UCLA.*
